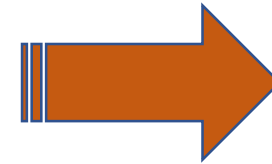
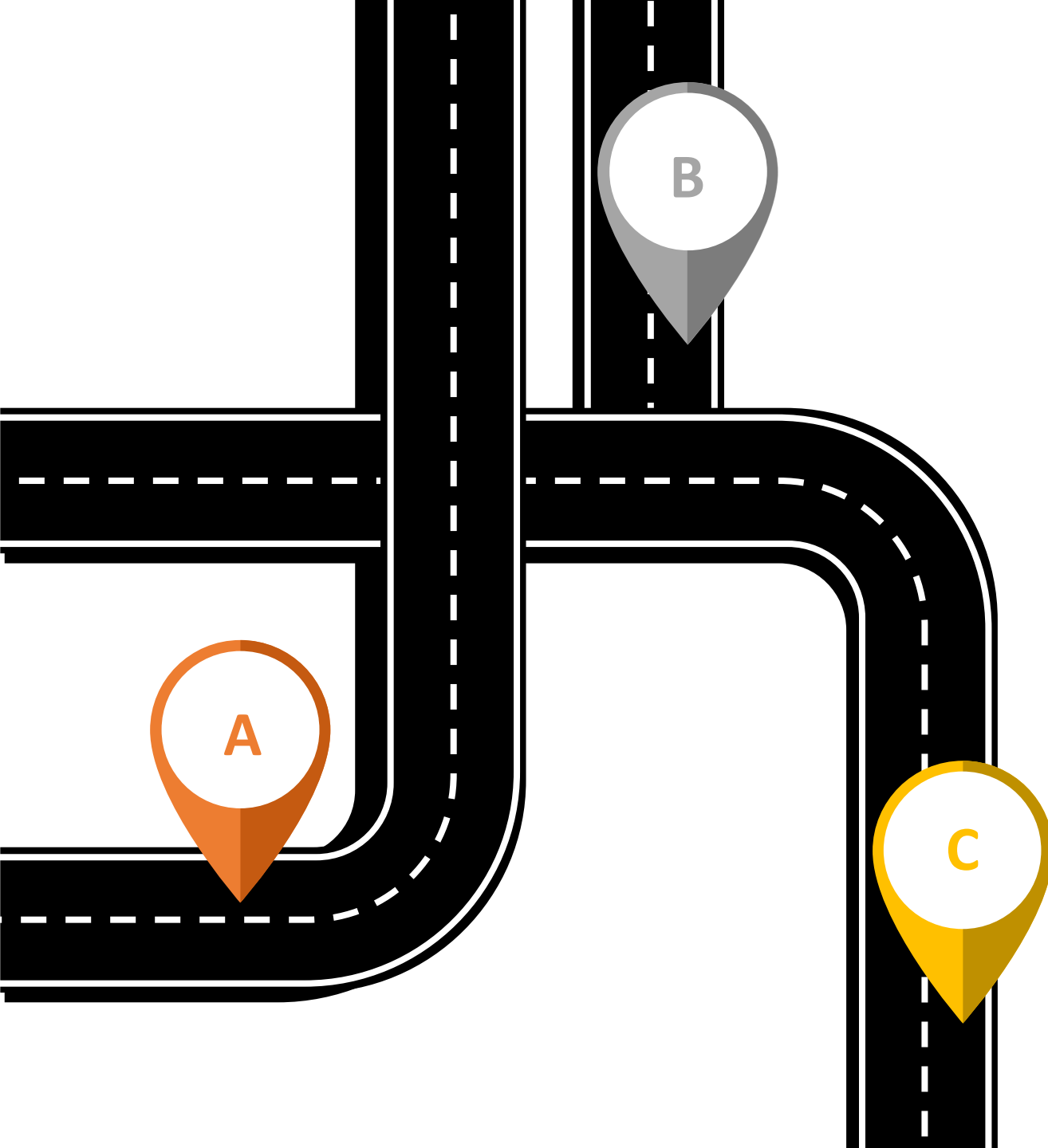


# THE ROAD TO POVERTY

## ISSUE A

Primary and Senior school lessons are only taught in English



## ISSUE B

Ethnic minorities make up the majority of non-English speakers. This results in the majority of children in this demographic group not being able to access education or gain any qualification.



## ISSUE C

Ethnic minorities face income inequality as they cannot access all education opportunities or jobs that require English.
